Sign Up for Dinner for Six

Do you want an opportunity to connect with other people from Trinity? We are organizing groups of people who will meet up for dinner. It's called "Dinner for Six." To participate, you sign up for a three-month period, and you will be organized by the church office into groups. You agree to host dinner one time during the three-month period at your home or another place (see FAQ below), providing the entrée. The other times, you bring either the salad/rolls or the veggie/dessert (determined by the host). This is a great way to get to know other people in a more casual setting.



Have questions? Read over these FAQs and if you don't see your question covered, call the church office at 760-347-0604.

- ♦ What exactly does the host do? They provide the location that month, decide the time and date to meet that month, provide the main dish that month, and they ask about allergies in the group and make them known (dairy/gluten free, etc.). You only host once during the three-month period and the other two times, you are the guest and just need to bring what category that month's host assigns to you.
- ♦ What if I can't host where I live? There are a few options for you. If the weather is good, you could meet at a park if it is manageable for the others in the group. You could meet at a restaurant, but it would be best to check that it is affordable for other people. You could also host it at church in the Fellowship Hall/Patio if it is available and if you clean up completely after the event is done.
- ◆ This seems like a couples thing and I'm single. Can I participate? Of course! We will be designing the groups with the available people to make a group as close to six people as possible.
- ♦ What dates are we meeting? Our first suggested meeting for Dinner for Six is September 11th. We will suggest other dates for the other months but if your group can't meet then, pick another date during the month.
