### Burdens and Standing in the Gap

Intercessory prayer defined: to make requests to God the Father, in the name of Jesus, for others.

Standing in the gap: A term Christians use. Usually meaning to come between God and others by praying for them.

Examples: Ezekiel 22:30; Moses in Psalm 106:23; 1 Samuel 12:23; Jesus in John 17:15-21.

Hebrews 7:25 says that Jesus lives to intercede for us. Romans 8 reinforces that truth and adds that the Holy Spirit also intercedes for us.

Burdens: Another term Christians use. Meaning the Holy Spirit gives you a particular compassion, an unselfish and sometimes intense concern for others that you didn't have before.

Examples: **Nehemiah 1:2-11**, Paul in **Romans 9:1-3**, **10:1**, and many others in both Testaments.

# Methods of Intercessory Prayer

Persistence at the throne of grace. Remember it is a Throne of Grace and that you are encouraged to come often and to come boldly. Luke 11:9-13, Luke 18:1-8, Hebrews 4:14-16

Pleading the Word: "Lord, you have said!" Jacob in Genesis 32:12, Jacob pleads God's Word back to Him, "For You have said..."

Pleading God's attributes: James 5:11 "...the Lord is very compassionate and merciful."

Exodus 34:5-7

Loud cries and tears: Hebrews 5:7 tells us Christ prayed with loud cries and tears. He wept over at least two cities.

# Intercessory Prayer and Revival

The history of the church includes hundreds of revivals and outpourings of God's Spirit. Intercessory prayer can sometimes be at the root of it. Examples: Peter's sermon in Acts 2; revival in the United States in 1857-58 which spread to England and Wales and more; Wales in 1905; Jesus Generation 1966. Tim Keller defines revival as an intensification of the Holy Sprit's normal ministries.

**Psalm 80** is a prayer for revival.

#### Intercession and Current Events

Pray for the nations: Psalm 2. "Ask of Me and I will give you the nations..." Example: World Watch.

An example of intercession: Solomon's dedication of the temple in 1 Kings 8:22-61.
