Dear Friends in Christ,

A few months ago, Alain helped a friend record and orchestrate a song that had been specially composed to be sung at the baptism of a family member. This last month, it was his 16-year-old niece who wanted to prepare her composition to surprise and sing for her brother's baptism. And now it's her 13-year-old cousin in far away Marseille who's recording her songs that praise the Lord and sending them to Alain "for his opinion." These youngsters seem to already have a good handle on the situation. We can certainly praise the Lord for this new generation's talent, but even more so, for their dedication and love for Him.

This summer, camps are back to going strong. One teenage camp is being held only six miles from our home. This week Alain will be going a couple times to give pep talks to the counselors and to help them with a few meetings. Then, as so many times in the past, he will be attending the family camp in Peyreguilhot near Agen where he will be preaching every morning August 14 to 21.

The children of the church of Pau had a great time one Saturday in July near a lady's home out in the countryside. Jôsy and Jacques had prepared all kinds of fun things to do together and a time of Bible story. Parents and children alike are talking about "doing that again!"

There were tears last Sunday. A Brazilian family who has been with us two years is obliged to go back to their country. They had come to France to get away from a bad situation. Now that they have become firm in the faith, they want to announce their decision to follow the Lord to their entourage. The wife is forcefully determined, the father is too, but chokes up when he talks about it. He's afraid for their safety. May the Lord intervene!
