Dear Friends,

As planned, the youth group led the worship service Easter Sunday. It was fun to see their smiling faces up on the stage! The sermon was given by the young man now in charge of the university students' group, Boris, who is quite a scholar. It was really good... although, being a "youth" presentation the congregation was certainly expecting something "lighter"!

The evangelistic meeting April 6<sup>th</sup> went over okay; we are praying to see people come back and make decisions.

There were only 20 at the church retreat where Alain went near Marseille, but the organizers were thrilled to see so many. Their church has only 15 who attend regularly now as several who had been for many years the church pillars have retired and moved away. Alain had lots of ideas for them when they asked his opinion on: "What do we do now?" It's a small group, but vibrant and very enthusiastic.

Alain came home with a new concern. During the conferences, he realized that his voice doesn't hold up very long. It reminded him of how he went hoarse during his last concert.
