

E-mail from our Global Partners in France Alain and Carol Larrey

July 25, 2022

Dear Friends in Christ,

What a hot summer! But can I complain about the heat when others are facing forest fires?! Then, there are areas who suffer a water shortage to the extent of not having tap water. Yes, personally, we have it good where we are; we just had a few days where we couldn't see the mountains because of the smoke which only reminded us to be grateful!

The Basque New Testaments have been placed into the hands of Christians who will be in that part of the country during summer vacation. Some are going to a "cousinade," a get-together for cousins who sometimes hardly know each other. Should be interesting to hear what happens!

Alain had invited the village's senior soccer team to his concert at the church. None came. A few days later, there was an end of the year dinner where the coach let him know that since he hadn't gone he wanted to make up for it by playing the new album over the loudspeaker. And he did... certainly the whole village heard it. Surprisingly, one of the guys must have already listened to the album so many times that he knew the words and could sing along! May the Gospel message take root in his heart.

Thank you for praying for Alain's family. His sister came to church one Sunday and stayed for a church picnic; it was quite a big deal for her. She's afraid of driving outside of a certain perimeter of her home, so her husband drove her to the local train station, and we picked her up near us to take her along. First, it was a lot of fuss trying to buy her train ticket, which had to be done online and their service isn't good. And then it meant getting up very early which made it a big day for her. But she was glad to have done it. Before leaving the church, she asked if she could take books from the library and collected a certain number of tracts saying she wanted to explain the faith to her children and grandchildren! (My next "mission" is to get her better materials to work with...)

Like I mentioned briefly in my last letter, Alain is officially withdrawing from the pastorate of the church of Pau. Believe it or not, he will be turning 70 at the end of the year! In 2018 when he was voted in for another four-year term, he had announced it would be his last. During this time, he continued training leaders while the board hunted for a successor. Seeing the difficulty in finding one, several took the church to heart and became more and more involved. Their concern for the church has us wondering if one or the other isn't seriously considering leaving his secular job to answer God's call to full-time ministry. Maybe the pastor we've been looking for will come from inside the church. We feel that something amazing is about to happen. It's really exciting to see the Lord at work.

Now, this doesn't mean we're through. Alain feels the need to be relieved of the load of organizing and overseeing of the church, which has enormously grown, even doubled, since pandemic restrictions have been lifted. After a time of rest, he will be available for service, preaching, teaching, and also for evangelistic meetings and conferences, in Pau and in other churches.

What does this mean for us financially? As of October the church of Pau will discontinue Alain's remuneration; French retirement benefits, which will be about half that, will begin. We've been expecting and saving up for this day. But yes, we will remain very grateful for the support received through FABM!
