"Walking By The Spirit" Galatians 5:19 Pastor David Gordon 6/6/2021

We see a church of people that are filled with the Holy Spirit. We see a church of people that love God with all of their heart, soul, mind, and strength, and love each other and their brothers and sisters around the world, with the love of Christ.

- 1. Our hearts and minds have been corrupted by sin. In our sexual life, that sin takes at least three forms.
 - a. Homosexuality Romans 1:26-27
 - b. Adultery Proverbs 6:32, Hebrews 13:4
 - c. Sex outside of marriage John 4:15-18, 1 Corinthians 7:1-9
- 2. Walking by the Spirit means living a life of sexual purity.
- 3. Sin is heart contamination. Matthew 23:27
- 4. Religion cleans the outside; Jesus cleans the inside. Ephesians 5:25-27

How to maintain sexual purity

- 1. <u>Abide</u> in Christ, and surrender completely to His work in your life. John 15
- 2. Keep a pure mind. Proverbs 4:23, Matthew 5:27-28, James 1:15
- 3. <u>Replace</u> the junk in your mind with God's Word. Psalm 119:11
- 4. <u>Flee</u> temptation Genesis 39:7-12, 1 Corinthians 6:18
- 5. <u>Confess</u> your sins and struggles to close Christian friends and accept their help. Hebrews 3:13
- When you mess up, run to Jesus, and receive His <u>help</u> and <u>forgiveness</u>. Luke 18:13, John 8:11, Romans 5:20, Hebrews 4:15-16, Hebrews 10:17
