THE GOSPEL IN A NUTSHELL

Faith is not just an <u>opinion</u> about Jesus. Faith is not just agreeing with the facts about Jesus. Faith is trusting in Christ so sincerely that your belief <u>changes</u> and <u>shapes</u> the way you live your entire life. **James 2:14-26**

- 3. Reaching people for Christ requires follow up. Matthew 28:18-20
 - a. When we lead people to Christ, we must build them into disciples.

A disciple is a student who devotes himself to following and obeying a master.

To be someone's disciple is much more than just learning a skill from someone. It is adopting your teacher's way of life.

- b. When we lead people to Christ, we must <u>baptize</u> them. **Colossians 1:28-29**
- c. When we lead people to Christ, we must teach them to obey Christ's commands.

When you give birth to a spiritual baby, bring them home.

When you lead someone to the <u>Head</u> (Christ), you must connect them to the <u>body</u> (the Church).

4. A Christian <u>life</u> is a great Christian <u>witness</u>. **Matthew 5:16**

The best thing you can do to prepare yourself for presenting the gospel is to read your Bible daily.
