

## E-mail from our Global Partners in France Alain and Carol Larrey

Hello Everyone!

Alain continues to put songs online. He is informed of the cities where people are listening, so when it's in the States he comes to ask me "Who do we know who lives in...?" Sometimes I hear an "Oh! Wow!" and I can guess that the name of a city in Israel or some unexpected country has popped up! This week there was Kiev. He could also see what they had been listening to: Psalm 23...

David Price, pastor/missionary in nearby Saint Gaudens, asked Alain to fill in a Sunday or two while he goes to the Ivory Coast for ministry. That gave Alain the idea of passing him a package of CDs to take along. Let's pray they serve for His glory!

It's always been hard to motivate people for the prayer meetings at the church. Usually we make a circle of about 12 chairs and are happy when more arrive. In that case chairs are added and the circle takes on an oval shape. During summer vacation, there are so few that the meetings are sometimes even cancelled. But this summer...Would you believe it?...The group grew and grew, week after week, to now an average 60 in attendance. Praise the Lord!

Another answer to prayer...the church weekend in the mountains that marks the new school year. A couple years ago, since we were so few—maybe 25 who cared to go—there was talk of not continuing. This year, there was a large attendance of 90 who went for all three days, another dozen came just for Saturday and even more just for Sunday. Alain went for Saturday, but on Sunday he was in charge of the worship service back in Pau. That's because nobody wanted to stay behind to open the doors or lead the singing or preach or tend to the sound system. We wondered who would be there, maybe a few old folks...? A man who sat in the back thought it was so unusual that he decided to count...48!

Alain's sister had come partway by train. After the service, we accompanied her home where we had dinner with her husband and Camille. They all seemed a lot less stressed than the last time we saw them. I must add that never before have we had such good opportunities to talk about faith. The questions kept coming. Especially from her husband.

Thank you for remembering them (and us!) in your prayers!
