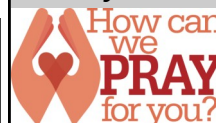

Hello from Southern France! Time for some news...

Restrictions being lifted, face-to-face visits have become possible. On Monday Alain got to go to the home of a new convert where the two of them got carried away playing guitars and listening to each other's compositions. During the same time Carol was visiting a Brazilian whose family has been severely hit with Covid.

After the worship service one Sunday, the church musicians were invited for an outdoor barbecue/potluck. It was a blessing, but also very funny... They kept referring to the two of us as "the old folks" ("let's let the old folks sit at the table" etc.) It was kind of tough to be considered of another age group, but, oh well, can't complain about being pampered!

During the get-together, one of the newer singers in the group took off her jacket. I kind of wondered why she wore such an outfit in hot weather. It became evident why, but it wasn't me who blurted: "You have tattoos!" Sure enough, she had some pretty impressive ones. It was the opportunity she was waiting for to give her testimony. Before coming to the Lord which was not too long ago, she had been into the New Age movement where each of these tattoos has a strong significance. As she puts it, "they represent gods of a false religion." Then she explained her dilemma. Should she undergo treatments to take them off, they would show up just as much, going from dark black to white on her black skin. She showed how she had tried to modify them. She had added a Bible verse. These tattoos are why she had decided to always wear long sleeved and high-necked clothing while at church, to not shock anyone. Although she regrets them, with a big smile she said how she rejoiced at the numerous opportunities they gave to witness. She and her husband, newlyweds who arrived from Lyon about a year ago, are a great joy to have in our church in Pau.
