1. Do you believe Jesus is Lord and God the Father raised Him from the dead?

Romans 10:9-10 (NASB-95)

- ⁹ ...if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; ¹⁰ for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.
- 2. Miracles happen in God's timing.
- 3. Jesus is present with us, and is able to celebrate or grieve with us.
- 4. The resurrection of Jesus is essential to our Christian faith.

Six Holiday Pests

- a. <u>Bitterness</u>: Instead of displaying the kindness of the Holy Spirit, we hold on to a bitter attitude of resentment.
- b. <u>Wrath</u>: Instead of displaying the patience of the Holy Spirit, we lose our temper, and display hot anger in our words and actions.
- c. <u>Anger</u>: Instead of responding with compassion and understanding, we allow anger to determine our attitudes and actions.
- d. <u>Clamor</u>: Instead of a kind and gentle response, we respond with shouting or yelling.
- e. <u>Slander</u>: Instead of using our words to build someone up and encourage them, we say negative hurtful words to them or about them.
- f. <u>Malice</u>: Instead of praying for the person, and being committed to blessing them, our anger and unforgiveness drive us to hurtful words and actions.
