- b. Wrath: Instead of displaying the patience of the Holy Spirit, we lose our temper, and display hot anger in our words and actions.
- c. Anger: Instead of responding with compassion and understanding, we allow anger to determine our attitudes and actions.
- d. Clamor: Instead of a kind and gentle response, we respond with shouting or yelling.
- e. Slander: Instead of using our words to build someone up and encourage them, we say negative hurtful words to them or about them.
- f. Malice: Instead of praying for the person, and being committed to blessing them, our anger and unforgiveness drive us to hurtful words and actions.
