- 3. What do you think of when you hear "eternal life"? What is the eternal life that Jesus has offered to us?
- 4. Read Revelation 21:4. Why is it significant that the eternal life that Jesus has offered to us is free from death, sorrow, crying, and pain?
- 5. Read Matthew 13:44. What does the treasure represent? Why was this man willing to give up everything that he had in exchange for it? What does that tell us about the worth of this treasure?
- 6. In this message we talked about how we experience many blessings in this life, but they all expire or end. What are some blessings that you have in your life? How does it make you feel that the blessing of eternal life will never end?
- 7. Read John 10:28. Who gives eternal life? What does Jesus promise to those who are have eternal life?
