MESSAGE TO CONVERSATION GUIDE

Week 1 | Better Together

1. What are some things that just better when you're with other people?

- 2. Read 1 Samuel 23:15-18. How would you be feeling if you were in David's shoes and you learned that the king was trying to kill you?
- 3. David needed Jonathan's support in that situation, showing us that even the strongest Jesus followers need support and community. How can a small group assist one another when people in the group are facing difficult life situations?
- 4. Read 1 Samuel 23:16. This verse says that Jonathan made an intentional effort to go to meet David when David was struggling. What does his example teach us about how we should support others in our small group? Is there a time when someone in your small group has reached out to you during a difficult time in your life?
- 5. In this message, we learned that **we strengthen each other in Jesus.** What are some ways that we can strengthen each other in Jesus?
- 6. Read Hebrews 3:12-14. How can we help each other to stay focused on Jesus?
- 7. Read 1 Samuel 23:17. We see Jonathan encouraging David by reminding him of God's promises. What are some promises of God that can we can remind others of when they're facing difficulties?
- 8. Read Hebrews 10:24-25a. What are ways that we can motivate each others to acts of love and good works?
- 9. Why is it important that we do not neglect to meet with other Jesus followers regularly?
