MESSAGE TO CONVERSATION GUIDE

All I Want For Christmas | ...is a little less disappointment

- 1. We started out this msg with a few fun Christmas polls like, *real tree or fake tree* and *color lights or white lights*. What was your answers for those 2 Christmas polls?
- 2. This message was called *All I Want For Christmas…is a little less disappointment.* What's 1 gift you always asked for as a kid and never received and it led to some disappointment?
- 3. In this message, Joel said that we have this idea of The Original Christmas Story that it was perfect and magical like a Hallmark Christmas movie. What are some elements of the Christmas story that go against this picture perfect Christmas?
- 4. Joseph can be overshadowed in the Christmas story but he plays an important role. Joseph also had moments of disappointment in the Christmas story. Read Matthew 1:19 and talk about Joseph's disappointments.
- 5. Around the Christmas season, we can face our own disappointments. Our relationships, friendships, finances, may not be in a good place. Perhaps we're missing a lost loved one. Do you face disappointments at Christmas and how to you try and navigate that?
- 6. Joel talked about a significant snow storm from years ago and how his brothers house was a refuge in that storm. How can God be our refuge in our storms and disappointments?
- 7. Read Matthew 1:20-21. How did God show up to Joseph when disappointment showed up in Joseph's life? How can this event be our refuge even in our disappointments?
- 8. Read Isaiah 53:6. What do you recall from this message about our Biblical nickname as sheep? How does Isaiah 53:6 tie in the Christmas story to our lives?
- 9. Jesus also had a nickname. Read Matthew 1:23 and share what Jesus' nickname is, what it means, and why that matters in our disappointments.
- 10. What was your biggest takeaway from this discussion or message?
