MESSAGE TO CONVERSATION GUIDE

I Got Good News | Week 2 | Share The Experience

- 1. Joel started out this message by telling a story when he had to fast for hours before having bloodwork done, which made him extremely hungry (and hangry). What happens to you when you're extremely hungry and what food do you crave the most?
- 2. The tie in with the opening story is that, we live in a world that's also spiritually hungry. How do you see this when you look at the world or people in your life?
- 3. Read John 4:25-26. The woman in this story didn't *know* Jesus but how can you tell she was spiritually hungry from her words?
- 4. There are around 8 billion people on earth. In many ways, we're all different. However, there's some ways that we're all the same. For instance, *we all want to be loved. We all want to know we're valuable. & we all want to be shown grace.* Do you agree with that? How do you think 'The Good News' can be a solution for this?
- 5. Read John 4:17-18. What do we learn about the woman Jesus is talking to at the well from this passage? Why do you think Jesus chose her in this story versus someone who is more successful at life?
- 6. Certainly one of the reasons Jesus chose a broken woman is because we all see ourselves as a little bit broken so she's relatable. With that in mind, discuss this quote from the message, *most of us think that God loved the world, we're just not always sure he likes me.*
- 7. Read 1 John 1:9, Romans 8:1, & Ephesians 2:8-9. How do those verses say that bust the myth we believe about ourselves from question #6.
- 8. Read John 4:28-30, 39. After the woman in the story experienced Jesus, what did she do? What takeaway can we act on based on her reaction to Jesus?
- 9. Have you ever shared Jesus with people or invited someone to church? If so, can you share that experience. If not, is there something that holds you back?
- 10. One of our final takeaways from this message was to share your Jesus story and share your church with someone. How have you processed that since Sunday?
