MESSAGE TO CONVERSATION GUIDE

Merry & Bright | Week 1 | Light Up The Darkness

1. The Christmas season is in full swing! Have you started to decorate yet? What's your favorite & least favorite part about decorating? Are you a yard/house decorator...why or why not?

- 2. In this message, Joel said *just because it's 'the most wonderful time of year' doesn't mean that everything is always wonderful.* What are some things that make the Christmas season hard (or dark) for people (you can answer this personally if you'd like).
- 3. Read Isaiah 9:2 which is a prophesy/prediction about Jesus around 700 years before His birth. What jumps out at you about this verse & why do you think Isaiah chose to describe Jesus as a *great light*?
- 4. Isaiah wrote those words about Jesus 700 years before Jesus (ie the *light*) was born. Have you ever felt like darkness in your life would never end? What did you do? What do you see now that you didn't at the time?
- 5. Sometimes the darkness & negativity we face is magnified by the negative influences we let in our life. In this message, Joel said *what if instead of writing a Christmas list, you wrote a 'Who am I letting influence me' List?* Why do you think that list matters, especially at times of darkness?
- 6. Read Isaiah 9:4. Do you remember what *the army to Midian* reference means? How does this apply to how God can break through our darkness when we depend on Him?
- 7. Read Isaiah 9:6-7. How does Isaiah's description of the coming Messiah give you peace & hope?
- 8. Joel ended this message by saying that Jesus has a way of plugging into our lives & lighting up the dark. How have you seen Him do that in your life?
