MESSAGE TO CONVERSATION GUIDE

Week 3 | Be The Ant

1. In the beginning of this message, Joel asked everyone what there thoughts were on scrapple. So where do you land on this important topic?

- 2. In this message, we started with talking about stress. What are some every day stressors for you you?
- 3. Did it surprise you to learn that 69% of people stress about money and that 58% of Americans have less than \$1,000 saved? What do you think the connection is between those stats?
- 4. Read Proverbs 6:6-8 & talk about what we can learn from ants & how does this relate to money?
- 5. In this message, we learned that we save for 3 things, *emergencies*, *purchases*, & *the future*. Give a few examples of each.
- 6. About 30% of our money goes to the house, another 30% to cars & food, another 20% to health, and last 20% goes towards personal stuff. If you *had* to find 10% to save for later (remember the ants)...how would you go about it?
- 7. We learned that we make money two ways...people make money & money makes money. In the Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25)...how did money make money?
- 8. Read Proverbs 24:3-4. Money Making Rule #1 was *don't invest in things you don't understand*. Have you ever done this & what was the outcome?
- 9. Read Ecclesiastes 11:2. Money Making Rule #2 was *don't put all your eggs in 1 basket*. Does it surprise you that the Bible gives such clear investing advice? What do you think the verse you just read means to do & not to do?
- 10. Read Proverbs 13:11 & discuss what your 1 takeaway was from this message.
