1. What stood out to you from the video?
2. If kids are antifragile like trees, then they need both nutrient-rich soil and age-appropriate wind to develop deep roots. How is your kids' soil? (Is it nutrient rich enough?) What kind of winds are they experiencing? (Hurricane-level? Not enough? Do you have multiple kids who are experiencing the same storm but enduring it differently?)
3. How do you feel when you see a rainbow flag symbolizing LGBTQ Pride? What do you do with your feelings? How have you led your kids when you encounter a rainbow flag together, or how do you hope to lead them in the future?
