Christ Is Your Life

Colossians 3:1-17

Preaching: Ryan Dattilio

Main Point of the Sermon:

Christians have been united with Christ in his death, life, and future glory. We live out that reality now by putting off sin and putting on Christ's likeness.

1. Having Been Raised with Christ, Seek Him (Colossians 3:1-4)

2. Christ is Your Life, so Live Like Him (3:5-17)
 - a. Having Died, Put Off the Old Self (3:5-11)
 - i. Command to Put the Earthly to Death (3:5-8)

 - ii. Grounds for Command: Old Self Put Off and New Self Put On (3:9b-11)

 - b. Having Put on the New Self, Be Clothed in Christ's Likeness (3:12-17)
 - i. Command to Put on Christ's Likeness (3:12-16)

 - ii. Command to Do All for Christ (17)
