Romans 1:16-17

Main Point of the Sermon:

The Gospel Is God's Power to Save All Who Believe Its Message.

Note on the Outline:

There's not an outline for this sermon. Instead of breaking it into parts, we're going to take Romans 1:16–17 as one big thought and walk through it together.
