Theme: “Raising Up”

“Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you.” – Ephesians 5:14 (ESV)

Prayer Focus Points

1. Personal Revival

Ask God to stir a deeper intimacy with Him in your own heart. Pray that each believer will rise up to live fully surrendered to Christ.

- *Psalm 139:23–24* – “Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!”
 - *James 4:8* – “Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.”

2. Revival in the Church

Pray for the Spirit to break down walls of apathy and division, replacing them with unity, passion, and boldness.

- *Acts 4:31* – “And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.”

- *2 Chronicles 7:14* – “If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

3. Salvations and Evangelism

Pray for a fresh burden to share the gospel. Ask God to prepare hearts to receive the message of Christ and for many to be saved.

- *Romans 10:14–15* – “How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent?”
 - *Matthew 9:37–38* – “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.”

4. Anointing on the Speakers and Musicians

Lift up each speaker by name, asking God to give them boldness, clarity, and power as they share His Word.

- **Brian Looney** (Sunday AM) – Pray for a strong opening message that prepares hearts.
 - **Jerry Lester** (Sunday PM) – Pray for wisdom and encouragement for the evening service.
 - **Shannon Prater** (Monday) – Pray for conviction and transformation through the Word.
 - **Shea Shrader** (Tuesday) – Pray for a clear presentation of the gospel and urgency for souls.
 - **Buck Meade** (Wednesday) – Pray for a strong closing night that seals God’s work in hearts.
 - *Ephesians 6:19* – “...that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel.”
 - Pray for our worship leaders each night That God would be exalted and turn each heart towards His glory.

5. Spiritual Boldness and Intimacy

Pray that believers will rise up, live boldly in their faith, and walk in deeper intimacy with Christ.

- *Philippians 3:10* – “That I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death.”

- *Hebrews 12:1–2* – “Let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith...”

6. Protection and Unity

Pray for protection over our church family, the speakers, and their families. Ask God to bind the enemy from bringing distraction, division, or discouragement.

- *John 17:21* – “That they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.”
 - *1 Peter 5:8–9* – “Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith...”

7. Children’s Workers

- Pray for safety and opportunity to even revive the children by teaching the Word of God.
- Pray for parents who can have undistracted worship encounter.

Daily Prayer Commitment

- Set aside **10–15 minutes daily** leading up to the revival.
- Pray through these points, lifting up specific names and needs as the Spirit leads.
- Fast from something each Thursday until revival—whether food, media, or a habit—to seek God with greater focus.
