

## Small Group Guide: The Reign of God

### Opening Prayer

### Key Scripture: Psalm 93

#### Discussion Questions:

1. What stood out to you most from the sermon on Psalm 93? Why?
2. The sermon emphasized God's universal reign. How does knowing that God reigns over everything impact your daily life and perspective?
3. Discuss the concept of God's eternal reign. How does this differ from earthly rulers and kingdoms?
4. The sermon mentioned God's reign being challenged by sinful rebellion. In what ways do you see this rebellion manifested in the world today?
5. How does the image of God laughing at human attempts to overthrow Him (Psalm 2) affect your understanding of His sovereignty?
6. The pastor highlighted God's mighty reign, especially in salvation. Share a time when you experienced God's power in your life.
7. How can we cultivate a deeper trust in God's "sure reign" and His trustworthy decrees?

#### Key Takeaways:

1. God's reign is universal, eternal, mighty, and certain.
2. Nothing can challenge or overthrow God's sovereignty.
3. God's word (the Bible) is trustworthy and a source of confidence for believers.
4. The greatest display of God's power is in the salvation of sinners.

#### Practical Applications:

1. Spend time this week meditating on Psalm 93 and Psalm 2. Journal your reflections.
2. Identify an area of your life where you struggle to trust God's reign. Commit to praying about it daily.
3. Share the gospel with someone this week, remembering that God's power is at work in salvation.
4. Start a Bible reading plan to engage more consistently with God's trustworthy decrees.
