Opening Prayer

Key Takeaways:

- 2. Identify one area of your life where you can more intentionally "love God with all your heart, soul, and might." Make a plan to focus on this area this week.
- 3. Create a simple plan to share something about God's character or promises with someone in your life this week (family member, friend, coworker, etc.).
- 4. Reflect on God's faithfulness in your life. Write down 3-5 ways God has kept His promises to you personally.

Closing Prayer: Thank God for His care, faithfulness, and promises. Ask for His help in loving Him more deeply and sharing His word more consistently.
