### GOD STORY

- Have someone in your group share a God Story or testimony of how God has moved in their life.

### INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Besides Jesus, who is someone you would consider the GOAT (Greatest of All Time)? Why?
- Who is someone the world considers great? How well do you think they model Jesus’s idea of servant leadership?

### KEY PASSAGES:

- **Matthew 20:20-28** - What do you make of this story about Jesus’s disciples? Where do we see people acting similarly today?
- **1 Peter 5:2-3** - Have you ever served a leader like this? What was that experience like?
- **Philippians 2:3-11** - How does modeling Jesus’s attitude towards others actually give us more influence?

### GROUP DISCUSSION:

- What have you learned about leadership from non-religious sources?
- Do you think it is a bad thing to want influence or leadership? Why or why not?
- Where or who do you find it most difficult to serve humbly? Why?
- What roles do you fill that give you opportunities to practice servant leadership (i.e. parent, supervisor, teacher, etc.)?

### WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 52, we were challenged to do something this week for someone else that is uncomfortably humbling for you. What did you do and how did it go?
- Depending on when your group meets, you might not have reached the Hands section yet for your daily exercises in chapter 8. If that is the case, reflect back on the following question from last week’s Weekly Application.
  - On page 46, we were challenged to host a party like Zacchaeus to make Christ famous. Have you begun to make plans for such a party? What will it look like? Who will you invite?
