GOD STORY

 Have someone in your group share a God Story or testimony of how God has moved in their life.

INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Do you know anyone who seems driven by a clear life purpose? How does that affect their daily life?
- What do you think the purpose of your life is?

KEY PASSAGES:

- Matthew 28:18-20 Could Jesus have been any clearer about the life purpose of His followers? How are you striving to live this out right now?
- 2 Timothy 1:7-8 What are some fears you face when it comes to sharing Jesus with others?
- Luke 19:1-10 Do you know someone like Zacchaeus in your life? How do you think Jesus would engage them?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- What are some bad ideas people have about a "life's purpose"?
- What are some bad examples of people trying to share the gospel? How have these examples affected your willingness to share the gospel?
- On page 44, Mark shares what he believes is Jesus's method of reaching people: belong, believe, behave. How is this similar to or different from your experience with churches?
- How does this progression of belong, believe, behave transform how we engage people?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 46, we were challenged to host a party like Zacchaeus to make Christ famous. Have you begun to make plans for such a party? What will it look like? Who will you invite?
- Depending on when your group meets, you might not have reached the Hands section yet for your daily exercises in chapter 7. If that is the case, reflect back on the following question from last week's Weekly Application.
 - On page 40, we were challenged to share with an accountability partner what we discovered about ourselves in the day 2 exercise and ask what they think we can do to be more committed to fully obeying God. What did they say?
