GOD STORY

- Have someone in your group share a God Story or testimony of how God has moved in their life.

INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises?
- Have you ever gone “nose blind” to a smell and you no longer notice it? What about a sound?
- After reading Matthew 13, do you have eyes to see and ears to hear what Jesus says?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Isaiah 6:1-13** - How can we lose our spiritual sight and hearing?
- **James 1:22-25** - How does reading the Word but failing to apply it affect our ability to hear from God?
- **Titus 1:15-16** - How does a person get to the point of having a “corrupted” or “dead” conscience? What does that look like?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- From the parable of the sower (Matthew 13:1-9), which type of soil do you tend to be? What do you need to do to become good soil?
- What sets the good soil apart from the other soils?
- Share about a time when you felt you really heard from God.
- In your own words, why do you think Jesus taught in parables?
- People heard the gospel from Jesus and walked away. Does that encourage you or discourage you when it comes to sharing the gospel? Why?

- On page 210, we were challenged to write our own parable about seeing or hearing? Is anyone willing to share the story they wrote?
