GOD STORY

- Have someone in your group share a God Story or testimony of how God has moved in their life.

INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises?
- Can you think of someone who wouldn’t naturally have a lot of social influence but nevertheless has made a huge impact on the world?
- Why do you think God so often uses the unlikely outcasts to do great work?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **1 Corinthians 1:26-31** - How would you summarize what Paul is saying here?
- **Acts 4:13** - Does someone’s lack of education or theological training prevent them from having an impact for Jesus?
- **John 4:42** - What can we learn from this woman’s role in introducing her village to Jesus? Does it take any pressure off of you to realize she didn’t have all the answers or convince them, but simply introduced them to Jesus?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- Other than Jesus, who would you say are some of the most influential people in history?
- What kind of people does the world consider influential? How is that different from the kinds of people who are influential for Jesus?
- The prior week, we looked at Nicodemus. How are Nicodemus and the woman at the well similar? How are they different?
- What kind of influence do you hope to have on the world around you?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 82, we were challenged to think about one person we want to influence for Jesus. Who was that, and did you have an opportunity to influence them?
- Depending on when your group meets, you might not have reached the Hands section yet for your daily exercises in chapter 13. If that is the case, reflect back on the following question from last week’s Weekly Application.
 - On page 76, we were challenged to do one simple thing to make your commitment to Jesus more visible. What did you do and how did it go?
