WATCH:

GOD STORY

- Have someone in your group share a God Story or testimony of how God has moved in their life.

INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- When you were young, what did you want to be when you grew up?
- What advice would you give your younger self about the man or woman you wanted to become?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **Luke 2:41-52** - How does this story in Luke foreshadow the man Jesus would become?
- **1 Samuel 24:5-7** - What can we learn from David’s focus on God’s role in appointing Saul as his authority?
- **Romans 13:1-2 and Ephesians 6:5-8** - Jesus practiced submission to the authorities God placed in His life (Mary and Joseph). How can we practice submission to the authorities in our life?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- Do you find submission to authorities (employers or government officials) easy or difficult? Why?
- On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate yourself on your attitude and ability to submit to the authorities in your life?
- Why do you think God cares whether or not we obey the earthly authorities in our lives?
- What specific authority figure do you need to work to submit to this week?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 33, we were challenged to ask a friend to identify an act or discipline we have been putting off. Who did this, and what did that friend say?
