



3. We often want to look at how verses like these apply to others before we look at how they apply to us. What does that say about our self-reflectiveness? How can we continually shift the focus to better ourselves?
4. This passage can sometimes be looked at as a formula for marriage. Verse 6 references Abraham and Sarah. Investigate Abraham and Sarah's relationship in the Hebrew Bible. What can we learn from how they interact as a couple?
5. Think of the last time that you submitted to someone else in a relationship. How did that feel, how did that go?
6. John talked last week about how the church has abused the verses about slaves, ignoring the humanity of fellow image bearers as a result. How have these verses about marriage and relationships been abused as well?
