1. What was the highlight from Tom's message on Sunday? What was your big takeaway from the scriptures he covered?

2. As Jesus was heading to the Cross (Luke 18:31-34) he was interrupted two time. (Luke 18:35-19:9). Discuss how Jesus handled these interruptions and how you handle interruptions. Can you think of other examples in scripture where Jesus experienced a divine interruption? (Matthew 9:19-26)

3. In Luke 18:39 we see the crowd try to quiet the blind beggar. Whose voices do we (individually or corporately) unintentionally keep quiet? How can we be intentional to raise the voices of those that are unheard?

5. Zacchaeus responded to Jesus by giving his wealth away spontaneously. He valued the benefit of salvation greater than the loss of his wealth. Have you found that discipleship has a cost in your life? What would you say to a person that says the cost of following Jesus is too high?

4. In this passage we see Jesus compassionate to the beggar and the tax collector. We see Jesus was gracious to both the oppressed and the oppressor, in what ways can we follow his example?
