Connect

What is your favorite snack food?

Reflect

Read Matthew 5:13-16. What point from Sunday's message is especially memorable?

Explore

1. This week's verses teach that by being Jesus' disciples, we <u>are</u> salt and light. How does this happen in daily life? What are some ways that Christians dilute the salt and hide the light?

2. Too much salt ruins a dish, while too much light can be blinding. Discuss the importance of sensitivity to others as we live the way Jesus taught us (see 1 Corinthians chapter 9).

3. Matthew 5:16 links the light of Christ with good deeds as the natural outcome. See Ephesians 2:10 and James 2:14-17. How do good deeds reveal the reality of Christ?

4. Share your thoughts about how a Bible character such as Daniel, Joseph, Ruth or David – or a person in your own life – illustrates being salt and light to the world.

5. Being salt and light requires involvement with the world, not withdrawing (John 17:15). What are some risks in this participation, and how can we overcome them?
