The God Who Speaks...

1. Intentionally

a. Natural/ General Revelation

- i. Romans 1:19; Psalm 19
- ii. "The acts of creation were like God putting on His outside clothes in order that we might see who He is, what He is like, and what He has done." -John Calvin
- iii. "Something lives in every hue that Christless eyes have never seen." - Anna Letitia Waring

b. Special Revelation

- i. *Theopneustos* (2 Timothy 3:16)

2. Authoritatively

- a. The derived authority of the prophets: Jeremiah 1:9, Exodus 4:15-16, Isaiah 7:7, Amos 1:3, Jeremiah 2:2

b. The inherent authority of Christ: Matthew 5:21-22, 27-28; Matthew 7:29

3. Condescendingly

a. Hebrews 1:1-3, John 1:14

4. Relationally

a. Exodus 34:6, 2 Peter 3:18

5. Doxologically:

a. Romans 11:33-36
