

Q: What is the difference between the marriage supper of the lamb and the supper of the great God?  
What are the other significant suppers in the scriptures?

supper\* – 14x

5 different suppers of significance in the scripture

1. Last Supper 4x
2. Lord's Supper 2x
3. The supper of the great God 1x
4. Marriage supper of the Lamb 1x
5. The parable of the great supper 1x

1. Last Supper

Luk 22:14 KJV - And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him.

Luk 22:15 KJV - And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer:

Luk 22:16 KJV - For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.

Luk 22:17 KJV - And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide [it] among yourselves:

Luk 22:18 KJV - For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

Luk 22:19 KJV - And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake [it], and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

Luk 22:20 KJV - Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup [is] the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

Jhn 13:1 KJV - Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.

Jhn 13:2 KJV - And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's [son], to betray him;

Jhn 13:3 KJV - Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;

Jhn 13:4 KJV - He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.

Jhn 13:5 KJV - After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe [them] with the towel wherewith he was girded.

Jhn 13:10 KJV - Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash [his] feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.

Jhn 13:11 KJV - For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not all clean.

The Last Supper is the Passover meal that the Lord Jesus Christ eats with the disciples

The Lord eats the cup and the bread

The Lord washes the feet of the disciples

The Lord identifies Judas as the traitor

The Last Supper is a one-time event

## 2. Lord's Supper

1Co 11:20 KJV - When ye come together therefore into one place, [this] is not to eat the Lord's supper.

1Co 11:21 KJV - For in eating every one taketh before [other] his own supper: and one is hungry, and another is drunken.

1Co 11:22 KJV - What? have ye not houses to eat and to drink in? or despise ye the church of God, and shame them that have not? What shall I say to you? shall I praise you in this? I praise [you] not.

1Co 11:23 KJV - For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the [same] night in which he was betrayed took bread:

1Co 11:24 KJV - And when he had given thanks, he brake [it], and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

1Co 11:25 KJV - After the same manner also [he took] the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink [it], in remembrance of me.

1Co 11:26 KJV - For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

The Lord's supper is a remembrance of the Lord's death

The Last Supper is a one-time event

The Lord's Supper is an event that we should continue to observe

## 3. The supper of the great God

Rev 19:11 KJV - And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him [was] called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Rev 19:12 KJV - His eyes [were] as a flame of fire, and on his head [were] many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

Rev 19:13 KJV - And he [was] clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:14 KJV - And the armies [which were] in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

This is the Second Coming

Rev 19:15 KJV - And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Rev 19:16 KJV - And he hath on [his] vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

Rev 19:17 KJV - And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

This is the supper of the great God

The next verse explains exactly what it is

Rev 19:18 KJV - That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all [men, both] free and bond, both small and great.

The supper of the great God takes place at the SC

The armies of the kings of the earth gather to oppose the SC, and millions upon millions are killed

Their bodies are then eaten by the fowls of heaven

The supper of the great God is the fowls of heaven eating the dead bodies of the armies gathered to oppose the SC

This is obviously not a marriage supper

Rev 19:19 KJV - And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

#### 4. The marriage supper of the Lamb

Rev 19:6 KJV - And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.

Rev 19:7 KJV - Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

Rev 19:8 KJV - And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Rev 19:9 KJV - And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed [are] they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

The marriage supper of the Lamb is mentioned in Rev 19 before the SC is mentioned starting in Rev 19:11

But it is clear that the marriage supper of the Lamb doesn't actually take place until Rev 21 when the new heaven and new earth are revealed

Rev 21:1 KJV - And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

Rev 21:2 KJV - And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

The Lamb's bride is actually a city, the New Jerusalem

Rev 21:3 KJV - And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God [is] with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, [and be] their God.

Rev 21:9 KJV - And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

Rev 21:10 KJV - And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

The Lamb's bride is actually a city, the New Jerusalem

DW: The Lamb's wedding is when the New Jerusalem descends down from heaven to the earth  
That is when the marriage supper of the Lamb takes place

#### 5. The parable of the great supper

Luk 14:16 KJV - Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

This is the parable of the great supper

Luk 14:17 KJV - And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.

Luk 14:18 KJV - And they all with one [consent] began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

Luk 14:19 KJV - And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

Luk 14:20 KJV - And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.

Luk 14:21 KJV - So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.

Luk 14:22 KJV - And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room.

Luk 14:23 KJV - And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel [them] to come in, that my house may be filled.

Luk 14:24 KJV - For I say unto you, That none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper.

In this parable, Israel is the invited guests

But the vast majority of Israel makes excuses as to why they can't attend

God then extends the invitation to the rest of humanity and most of Israel is excluded

The significance of the parable is that God invites Israel to the marriage supper and an eternal relationship with Him but most of Israel refuses
