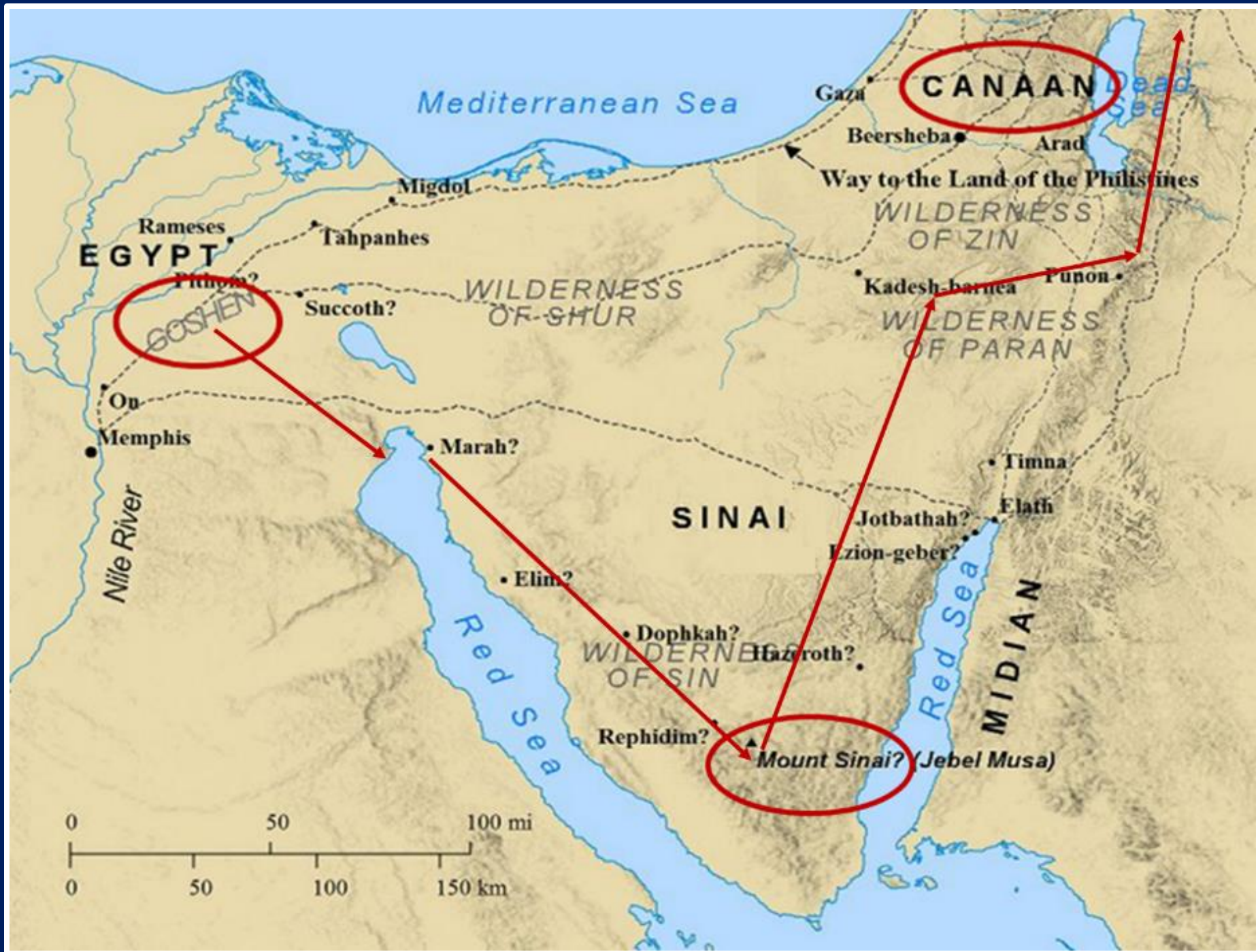
- Why redemption is necessary (Exod 1)

3 rd	From the Diaspora to Israel’s restoration	Ezekiel 36:24-28	Millennial Kingdom



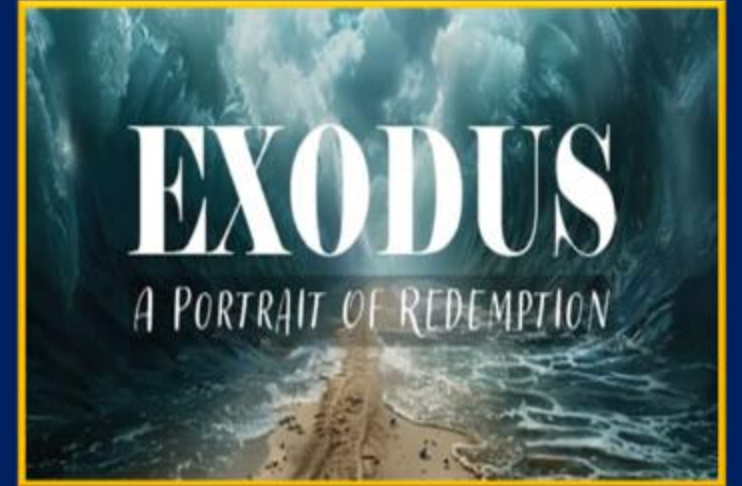
