### HOW DO YOU NEIGHBOR ONE DIFFERENT FROM YOU?

#### 1) RECOGNIZE YOUR PREJUDICES.

Prejudice: (prejudging) preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience.

#### 2) SEEK TO UNDERSTAND OTHERS.

#### 3) LOVE THOSE DIFFERENT FROM YOU.

- JUSTICE IS WHAT LOVE LOOKS LIKE ON THE OUTSIDE.
- RACISM, IN ITS MOST COMMON FORM IS AN ABSENCE OF LOVE—APATHY.

#### 4) GOD DESIRES UNITY IN HIS CHURCH AND DESPISES DIVISION.
