2. WHAT I CAN DO FOR DIFFICULT PEOPLE

A. OFFER GRACE

DON'T <u>GET MAD</u>

"When a fool is annoyed, he quickly lets it be known. Wise people will ignore an insult." Proverbs 12:16

DON'T <u>BAD MOUTH</u> THEM

"Disregarding another person's faults preserves love; but gossiping about them separates close friends." Proverbs 17:9

DON'T <u>RETALIATE</u>

"Do not do wrong to repay a wrong, and do not insult to repay an insult. But repay with a blessing, because you yourselves were called to do this so that you might receive a blessing." 1 Peter 3:9

B. OFFER FORGIVENESS

"You must make allowance for each other's faults and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." Colossians. 3:13

DON'T HOLD ON TO A HURT

"See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many." Hebrews 12:15

DON'T WAIT FOR AN <u>APOLOGY</u>

"Jesus said, 'Father forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." Luke 23:34
