4) **Two faith-filled followers: Simeon and Anna**

**Simeon: righteous, devout, and waiting**

*“[Simeon] was righteous and devout and was eagerly waiting for the Messiah to come and rescue Israel. The Holy Spirit was upon him...” Luke 2:25b*

**Anna: broken, but resilient**

*“Then she lived as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the Temple...worshiping God with fasting and prayer.” Luke 2:37*

5) **Belief is cheap. Faith costs everything.**

*“And if you do not carry your own cross and follow me, you cannot be my disciple. But don’t begin until you count the cost..”*
