THREE REALITIES ABOUT THIS DARE:

- Our words are only as credible as our CHARACTER.
- The true test of our character is what we do when no one is **LOOKING**.
- Good character is built on **FAITHFULNESS** to God and His way of life.

Proverbs 22:1 confirms the value of a good reputation: "A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches, loving favor rather than silver and gold."

Jesus said if your word has a good reputation, you don't need to make oaths:

"33 Again, you have heard that the ancients were told, 'YOU SHALL NOT MAKE FALSE VOWS, BUT SHALL FULFILL YOUR VOWS TO THE LORD.' 34 "But I say to you, make no oath at all... 37 "But let your statement be, 'Yes, yes' or 'No, no'; anything beyond these is of evil. Matthew 5:33-34a, 37

THREE GUIDELINES ON HOW TO BUILD GOOD CHARACTER

The Apostle Peter encourages us to "make every effort" to invest our lifetime in building a **MATURE** character. In 2 Peter 1 we find three ways to do this:

- **1. TRUST:** God is there to <u>HELP</u> you. vs. 3-4 God..."has given us everything we need for a godly life..."
- **2. BUILD:** Determine to make your <u>LIFE</u> count. vs. 5-9 "...make every effort to add to your faith..."
- **3. CONNECT:** It takes a godly **COMMUNITY** to grow character. vs.10-11 "...brothers and sisters, make every effort to confirm your calling and election."
