The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray. Proverbs 12:26

1) FOOLISH Friends Don't LISTEN

So don't bother correcting mockers; they will only hate you. But correct the wise, and they will love you. Proverbs 9:8

Solution: **CONSEQUENCES**

2) EVIL Friends Want to DESTROY

Warn a divisive person once, and then warn them a second time. After that, have nothing to do with them. Titus 3:10

Solution: **WARN** first, then **UNFRIEND**

3) WISE Friends Listen and SPEAK TRUTH In Love

Instruct the wise, and they will be even wiser. Teach the righteous, and they will learn even more. Proverbs 9:9

An open rebuke is better than hidden love! Proverbs 27:5a

Solution: Be wise to **IDENTIFY WISE** friends

4) Three Types of UNWISE Friendships:

- **COMPLIANT** + **COMPLIANT**
- **COMPLIANT** + **AGGRESSIVE**
- **COMPLIANT** + **NONRESPONSIVE**
