

Don't Let the Pressure Get to You: "How To's" from Jesus

Matthew 26:47-56 (NKJV)

1. **PRAY THROUGH** the pressure.

2. Don't let the pressure **CHANGE YOU**.

MATTHEW 26:51 *And suddenly, one of those who were with Jesus stretched out his hand and drew his sword, struck the servant of the high priest, and cut off his ear.*

JOHN 18:10 *Then Simon Peter, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus*

LUKE 22:51 *But Jesus answered and said, "Permit even this." And He touched his ear and healed him.*

3. Realize the pressure is **WORKING** for you.

MATTHEW 26:54 *How then could the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must happen thus?*

ROMANS 8:28 *And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.*

4. Put the pressure in **GOD'S HANDS**.

GENESIS 18:14 (AMP) *Is anything too difficult or too wonderful for the LORD? At the appointed time, when the season [for her delivery] comes, I will return to you and Sarah will have a son."*

JEREMIAH 32:17 (AMP) *'Ah Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! There is nothing too difficult or too wonderful for You—*

JEREMIAH 32:27 (AMP) *"Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh; is there anything too difficult for Me?"*

LUKE 18:27(AMP) *But He said, "The things that are impossible with people are possible with God."*

ISAIAH 53:7 *He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.*
