



**Signs You are Supposed to be a Blessing**  
*Esther 4:13 (NKJV)*

1. **Sign #1: You experience a SUDDEN BREAKTHROUGH.**
2. **Sign #2: ANOMALIES start appearing out of nowhere.**

**ESTHER 6:1-2** *That night the king could not sleep. So one was commanded to bring the book of the records of the chronicles; and they were read before the king. <sup>2</sup> And it was found written that Mordecai had told of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the king's eunuchs, the doorkeepers who had sought to lay hands on King Ahasuerus don't stay down long; Soon they're up on their feet...*

3. **Sign #3: You start getting blessed in UNUSUAL WAYS.**

**ESTHER 4:10** *Then the king said to Haman, "Hurry, take the robe and the horse, as you have suggested, and do so for Mordecai the Jew who sits within the king's gate! Leave nothing undone of all that you have spoken."*

**ESTHER 8:8** *You yourselves write a decree concerning the Jews, as you please, in the king's name, and seal it with the king's signet ring; for whatever is written in the king's name and sealed with the king's signet ring no one can revoke."*

**ESTHER 4:13-15** *And Mordecai told them to answer Esther: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews. <sup>14</sup> For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?" <sup>15</sup> Then Esther told them to reply to Mordecai: <sup>16</sup> "Go, gather all the Jews who are present in Shushan, and fast for me; neither eat nor drink for three days, night or day. My maids and I will fast likewise. And so I will go to the king, which is against the law; and if I perish, I perish!"*
