ACQUIRING THE TASTE FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

Psalm 23:1-6 (NKJV)

1. BE IN THE RIGHT PLACE.

2 SAMUEL 11:1-2 It happened in the spring of the year, at the time when kings go out to battle, that David sent Joab and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the people of Ammon and besieged Rabbah. But David remained at Jerusalem. ² Then it happened one evening that David arose from his bed and walked on the roof of the king's house. And from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the woman was very beautiful to behold.

2. FEED YOUR SOUL THE RIGHT FOOD.

PSALMS 51:10-11 Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. ¹¹ Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. ¹² Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me by Your generous Spirit. ¹³ Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners shall be converted to You.

PSALMS 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

MATTHEW 4:4 Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "
