

## ACQUIRING THE TASTE FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

*Psalm 23:1-6 (NKJV)*

### 1. BE IN THE RIGHT **PLACE**.

**2 SAMUEL 11:1-2** *It happened in the spring of the year, at the time when kings go out to battle, that David sent Joab and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the people of Ammon and besieged Rabbah. But David remained at Jerusalem. <sup>2</sup> Then it happened one evening that David arose from his bed and walked on the roof of the king's house. And from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the woman was very beautiful to behold.*

### 2. FEED YOUR SOUL THE RIGHT **FOOD**.

**PSALMS 51:10-11** *Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. <sup>11</sup> Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. <sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me by Your generous Spirit. <sup>13</sup> Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners shall be converted to You.*

**PSALMS 119:11** *Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.*

**MATTHEW 4:4** *Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "*

### 3. HAVE THE RIGHT **PERSPECTIVE**.

**JEREMIAH 31:3** *The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.*
