3: Even When You Fail, You Are On Jesus Mind.

- Psalm 139:17-18 NKJV ... How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! 18 If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; When I awake, I am still with You.
- Psalm 40:5 NKJV ... Many, O LORD my God, are Your wonderful works Which You have done; And Your thoughts toward us Cannot be recounted to You in order; If I would declare and speak of them, They are more than can be numbered.
- Jeremiah 29:11 NKJV ... For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

<i>]</i>	5: Sell Out to God.
	• John 21:6-7 NKJV He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish. 7 Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water.
	Matthew 6:33 NKJV But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

6: Put Your Setback in The Savior's Hands.

- a) He offers Peter another chance
- b) He blesses Peter with more than He deserves
 - John 21:11 NKJV ... Simon Peter went up and dragged the net to land, full of large fish, one hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not broken.
- c) He invites us into His presence
 - John 21:12 NKJV ... Jesus said to them, "Come and eat breakfast." Yet none of the disciples dared ask Him, "Who are You?"—knowing that it was the Lord. 13 Jesus then came and took the bread and gave it to them, and likewise the fish.
 - Hebrews 4:14-16 NKJV ... Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
- d) He Remove the shame and the guilt
 - John 21:9 NKJV ... Then, as soon as they had come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid on it, and bread.
 - John 21:14 NKJV ... This is now the third time Jesus showed Himself to His disciples after He was raised from the dead.
- e) He Turns What the enemy meant for evil around for our good
 - John 21:4-5 NLT ... At dawn Jesus was standing on the beach, but the disciples couldn't see who he was. 5 He called out..
- f) HE Makes us better
