


Don't Miss Your Moment

1 Kings 19:19-21 NKJV ... So he departed from there, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he was with the twelfth. Then Elijah passed by him and threw his mantle on him. 20 And he left the oxen and ran after Elijah, and said, "Please let me kiss my father and my mother, and then I will follow you." And he said to him, "Go back again, for what have I done to you?" 21 So Elisha turned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen and slaughtered them and boiled their flesh, using the oxen's equipment, and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he arose and followed Elijah, and became his servant.

Seizing Your Divine Moment by Going all In Requires:

1. Believing that God's Got Better For Each of Us.

- **John 10:10** NKJV ... The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

 ***The Take Away – We've Got to Believe! God's plan for our lives is better and greater than our plan for our lives.***

2. Being Sensitive to the Holy Spirit within Your Spirit.

- **Proverbs 20:27** NKJV ... The spirit of a man is the lamp of the LORD, Searching all the inner depths of his heart.
- **Psalms 37:4** NKJV ... Delight yourself also in the LORD, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.

3. Committing an act of spiritual Arson!

- **1 Kings 19:20-21** NKJV ... And he left the oxen and ran after Elijah, and said, "Please let me kiss my father and my mother, and then I will follow you." And he said to him, "Go back again, for what have I done to you?" 21 So Elisha turned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen and slaughtered them and boiled their flesh, using the oxen's equipment, and gave it to the people, and they ate. - **Luke 14:26** NKJV ... "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.

- **Isaiah 40:31** NKJV ... But those who wait (one version says trust) on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.
- **Habakkuk 2:3** NLT ... This vision is for a future time. It describes the end, and it will be fulfilled. If it seems slow in coming, wait patiently, for it will surely take place.
