

Hebrews 12:1-3 NKJV... Drop the Weight of Sin

1. Sin Stops Us From Enjoying the Abundant Life God Has for Us

- **Romans 6:6** NKJV ... knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be [a]done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.
 - **John 8:34** NKJV ... Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.

- **Psalm 51:10-11** NKJV ... Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. 11 Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. 12 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me by Your generous Spirit. 13 Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners shall be converted to You.

Makes Us Believe the Lie that God Doesn't Love Us

- **Romans 5:8-9** NKJV ... But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- **Romans 8:35-37** NKJV ... Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." 37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. 38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- **Jeremiah 31:3** NKJV ... The LORD has appeared [a]of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.
- **Proverbs 15:31** NIV ... Whoever heeds life-giving correction will be at home among the wise.

Makes Us Believe the Lie God Can't Forgive Us

- **Luke 23:34** NIV ... Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing
- **1 John 1:9** ... If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- **Isaiah 43:25** NKJV ... "I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins.
- **Micah 7:19** NIV ... You will again have compassion on us; you will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea.
- **Psalm 103:12** NIV ... as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.
