

## Listening to the Voice

Psalm 84:10 (NLT), John 10:3-5,10 (NKJV),

1. Trusting the voice requires your \_

LUKE 10:42 But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part.

**PSALM 34:8** *Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!*

**NUMBERS 6:24-27** "The LORD bless you and keep you; <sup>25</sup> The LORD make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; <sup>26</sup> The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace." , <sup>27</sup> "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

**1 KINGS 19:11-12** And behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake; <sup>12</sup> and after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice.

**JOHN 10:3-5** ...the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. <sup>4</sup> And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. <sup>5</sup> Yet they will by no means follow a stranger, but will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers."
