- **1 Samuel 16:7** NKJV ... But the LORD said to Samuel, “Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.”
- **1 Samuel 17:32** NKJV ... Then David said to Saul, “Let no man’s heart fail because of him; your servant will go and fight with this Philistine.”

Ways in Which God Cultivates An All-In Heart In Us

1. In how we understand our identity.

- **1 Samuel 17:33** (NKJV) ... And Saul said to David, “You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him; for you are a youth, and he a man of war from his youth.”
 - **1 Samuel 17:42-44** (NKJV) ... And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained[a]him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. 43 So the Philistine said to David, “Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?” And the Philistine cursed David by his gods.
 - **Prov 23:7** NKJV ... Cause as a man thinketh in his heart so is he.
 - **1 Samuel 17:39** NKJV ... I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them. And David took them off.

2. In how familiar we are with our covenant.

- **1 Samuel 17:36** NKJV ... Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living God.”
 - **Psalms 89:34** NKJV ... My covenant I will not break, Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.
 - **2 Corinthians 5:21** NKJV ... For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
 - **Luke 23:34** NKJV ... “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.”
 - **Galatians 3:13-14** NKJV ... Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”), 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

3. In how we use and understand our weapons.

- **2 Corinthians 10:3-4** NKJV ... For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. 4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds.

4. As we walk through our valleys

- **Psalms 23:4** NKJV ... Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.
 - **Psalms 23:5** NKJV ... You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies..
