## Cultivating an All In Heart - Part Two

- 1 Samuel 16:7 NKJV ... But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."
- 1 Samuel 17:32 NKJV ... Then David said to Saul, "Let no man's heart fail because of him; your servant will go and fight with this Philistine."

### Ways in Which God Cultivates An All-In Heart In Us

### 1. In how we understand our identity.

- 1 Samuel 17:33 (NKJV) ... And Saul said to David, "You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him; for you are a youth, and he a man of war from his youth."
- 1 Samuel 17:42-44 (NKJV) ... And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained[a]him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. 43 So the Philistine said to David, "Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?" And the Philistine cursed David by his gods.
- **Prov 23:7 NKJV** ... Cause as a man thinketh in his heart so is he.
- 1 Samuel 17:39 NKJV ... I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them. And David took them off.

 $m{st}$  David knew who he was even though everything in his environment screamed that he wasn't.

### 2. In how familiar we are with our covenant.

- 1 Samuel 17:36 NKJV ... Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living God."
- Psalm 89:34 NKJV ... My covenant I will not break, Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 NKJV ... For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
- Luke 23:34 NKJV ... "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."
- Galatians 3:13-14 NKJV ... Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

### 3. In how we use and understand our weapons.

2 Corinthians 10:3-4 NKJV ... For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. 4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds.

📌 Fight with the weapons God has given us.
