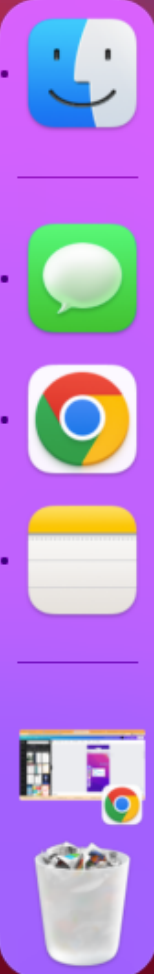



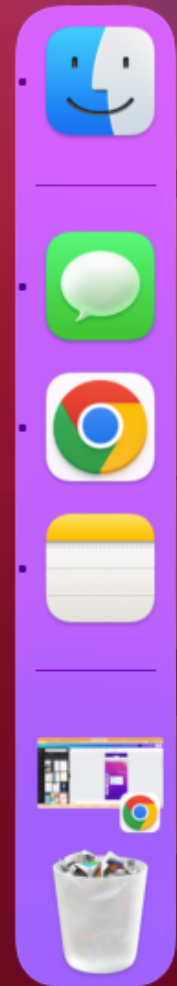

Everlasting Covenant - Dispensation of the Kingdom ✓	Covenant with all of God's creation but only ratified for those written in the Lamb's Book of Life before the world began (Rev 13:8; 17:8)	Matt 25:34; Mrk 10:30; 2 Tim Ti 1:1-3; 1 Pet 1:18; 1 Joh 2:25 God's Kingdom. Everlasting life. Redemption.	Same as those written in the Words/Promises	1 Pet 1:18 - 20; Rev 13:8 The blood of Christ, the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.		Conditional	Rom 16:25 Faith in Jesus Christ	Rev 20:12 - 15 Cast into the Lake of Fire for those not written in the Lamb's Book of Life.
Edenic Covenant - Dispensation of Innocence ✓	Covenant with Adam, thus mankind	Gen 1:26-28; 2:16,17 God gave man dominion over the whole earth to subdue and replenish it. Man was to be fruitful and multiply. He was not to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. (Man was doing this as a representative of God; Man was to submit all things to God concerning the earth.)	Gen 1:26-28; 2:16,17 Dominion, the ability to be fruitful and multiply, and the freedom to eat of any tree except one.	No blood was shed because there was no death in the earth when the covenant was cut.	Gen 1:26,27 God made man in His image - an act showing man's lordship over the earth.	Conditional	Gen 2:17 Adam was to not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.	Gen 2:17. Plus Gen 3:14-19 Death, both spiritual and physical. (Adam did not lose dominion, Gen 9:2; he just chose another god to whom he submitted his dominion, Jon 8:34).
Adamic Covenant (only viewing the redemptive plan) - Dispensation of Conscience ✓	Covenant with Satan (not man even though we call it the Adamic Covenant; "The Satanic Covenant" sounds evil even though it really is not)	Gen 3:14, 15, 21 - That there would be enmity between the snake and the woman and between his seed and her Seed. Her Seed would crush Satan and Satan would bruise His heal.	No blessings announced for Satan.	Gen 3:21 The blood of an innocent animal was shed (in making the coats of skins).	Gen 3:21 God made animal skins to cover man's nakedness - a forshadow of the defeat of Satan through the sacrifice of Jesus.	Unconditional	N/A	Gen 3:15 Satan would be crushed under the foot of the Seed of woman.
Noahic Covenant - Dispensation of Human Government ✓	Covenant with Noah, his seed, and all living creatures	Gen 6:18, 8:20,21; 9:8-17 That God would never again destroy the earth, all living creatures, and flesh on the earth with a flood again.	Gen 9:11 (Same as the Words/Promise)	Gen 8:20,21 The blood of burnt offerings of clean animals and birds.	Gen 9:12-17 God put a rainbow in the sky whenever a (rain)cloud shows - rainbows represent God's faithfulness to covenant. Abrahamic Covenant - Dispensation of Promise (Patriarchal) 	Covenant with Abraham and his seed	Gen 12:1-3, 7; 13:14-17; 15:1-21; 17:1-22; 22:15-18 Confirmed with Isaac in Gen 26:1-5; Confirmed with Jacob Gen 28:10-15. Abraham would be a great nation, would be blessed, his name would be great, he shall be a blessing, God will bless those that bless him and curse those that curse him, his seed shall inherit the land of Israel forever, his seed shall be as numerable as the dust of the earth, God would be his shield and exceeding great reward, his seed shall be numberable as the stars, God will multiply Abraham exceedingly, he shall be a father of many nations, kings shall come out of Abraham, God will be his and his seed's God, God would bless Sarah to be a mother of nations, kings shall come from her, his seed shall possess the gate of his enemies, and in his seed all nations of the earth will be blessed as an everlasting covenant. New Covenant - Dispensation of Grace ✓	Covenant with the Houses of Israel and Judah first, then to the rest of the world (Rom 1:16; 2:10; 9:4)	Jer 31:31-34; Eze 36:22 - 38; 37:16 - 28; Matt 26:26-29; Heb 8 - 10 God will put His Law in their inward parts and write It on their hearts, He will be their God and they will be His people, God will forgive their iniquity and remember their sin no more. God will gather the Jews out of all countries unto the land of Israel and He will cleanse them from filthiness and idolatry, they will have a new heart/spirit, and He will put His Spirit within them as well, He will cause them to walk in His statutes and keep His judgments, God will increase their corn, and will allow no famine, He will cause them to dwell in the cities and the wastes shall be built, and men shall increase in the cities like a holy flock. God will unite the other tribes of Israel with Judah and they shall be one nation forever, they shall dwell in the land of Israel, they will have one king, they will not be defiled again by sin but God will cleanse them, David shall be their king, and God will set His sanctuary in their midst forever.
